FULL-SIZE HOPETOUN MODEL BILLIARD TABLE, NO 4076, BY ALCOCK & CO (AGE C 1900)

After a successful term as Governor of the Colony of Victoria, 1889 to 1895, the popular Earl of Hopetoun was appointed the first Governor General of Australia. He held this position for only a brief period due to a disagreement with the Australian Government over expenses.

During the Earl's tenure Alcocks received permission to name a new model of Table after him – the Hopetoun model.

Owing to the Earl's early departure Alcocks made very few Hopetoun model Tables.

Consequently this attractive model Table came to be regarded as a rare piece.

Hopetoun model Table No 4076 is in excellent condition.
